(1) Municipal / Government membership fees shall be \$1,000 per year for federal and state agencies and jurisdictions with a population exceeding 100,000. The membership fee for other qualifying organizations and jurisdictions with populations less than 100,000 shall be \$500 per year.

(2) LDDI memberships run from July 1 through June 30 and are not prorated over a portion of a year. Organizations joining as members from July through December will pay the full year's membership amount. Organizations joining from January through June will pay 1/2 of the full year's membership.
